







# Twin Rivers CTE Area BACK TO SCHOOL PLAN 2021-2022

As of July 1, 2021, local school boards of public K-12 education institutions will be responsible for implementing whatever measures and restrictions deemed necessary and prudent to address the impact and spread of COVID-19 for their buildings, facilities and grounds, to include transportation. Educational governing bodies are encouraged to follow CDC guidance and any guidance that may be issued by the Indiana and Local Departments of Health and Education.

#### These guidelines may be altered <u>IF/WHEN</u> the high school of the program location enforces alternate policy. All questions or uncertainty should be directed to the Twin Rivers CTE Director for clarification.

### Twin Rivers will adhere to the following guidelines:

- Masks will not be required for students or staff at this time
- Students and staff are welcomed to wear masks if they wish.
- Follow IDOE attendance guidelines for students who are absent due to a COVID-19 related reason.
- Determine contact tracing requirements, if any, in conjunction with all Health Departments

#### **School Day**

- In-person instruction will continue to be provided 5 days a week.
- Virtual learning will not be an option for Twin Rivers students on a long term basis

#### **Entering Labs or Classrooms**

- Implement standard operating procedures while taking preventive measures such as:
  - Provide hand sanitizer for students and staff.
  - Continue established COVD-19 protocol for students/staff who feel ill/experience symptoms when they come to school.

#### **Field Trips**

• We are cautiously reinstating fieldtrips. Before planning your trip please check with your building principal to determine with your plan meets the safety measures for an allowable fieldtrip.

#### Vaccinations

- Follow Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) guidance if COVID-19 becomes a required or recommended vaccine. Currently, the COVID-19 vaccine is not listed as either a required or recommended vaccine. Should that change, religious and medical exemptions will be followed like with all other vaccines.
- Teach and reinforce good hygiene measures such as handwashing, covering coughs, etc.

## **Social Distancing**

• We will not be as strict as last year; however, the CDC recommendation is students sitting 3 feet apart when possible.

- Temperature of student will only be checked if student has signs of illness
