#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The program includes a broad base of courses and foundational skills related to health care career tracks. These courses enhance the students' potential for completing a degree in a healthcare field or seeking employment in a health care service agency. Upon successful completion of the needed requirements, students will qualify to sit for a certification exam to become a Certified Clinical Medical Assistant.

## **ADDITIONAL EDUCATION/TRAINING:**

The CCMA course is designed to prepare students to take the National Health career Association (NHA) Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) national certification examination. The course will prepare the student to work in multiple healthcare settings. Students will perform various clinical tasks to assist healthcare providers such as, administering medications and with minor procedures. Students complete 75 hours of classroom training and 90 hours of lab and clinical preceptorship.

## OCCUPATIONS UPON COMPLETION OF PROGRAM:

Upon successful completion of the National Health career Association (NHA) Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) national certification examination, students can pursue employment in multiple healthcare settings, such as Physician's Offices, Chiropractic Offices, Hospitals, Outpatient facilities and Group practices.
