

COLLISION REPAIR AND REFINISHING PROGRAM



Through intensive classroom and handson lab experiences, you will develop skills


based on both technical and general education.





VINCENNES UNIVERSITY TWIN RIVERS COLLISION REPAIR

Through a partnership between the Twin Rivers Program and Vincennes University, eligible high school seniors may enroll in college level Collision Repair and Refinishing classes at VU.

Students will travel to VU daily to take both lecture and lab courses. Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays will be lab time from 8:00AM until 11:50AM (Vincennes time). Tuesdays and Thursdays lecture will meet from 9:30AM until 10:50AM (Vincennes time) (18 Credit Hours if students take this for two semesters).

Students will be responsible to pay a lab fee for each of the two semesters (\$410 each semester) they attend VU. VU will provide a text book, safety glasses, respirator, and a set of tools for you to borrow.

You will be taking BODY 100 (Non Structural Repairs), BODY 100L (Non Structural Lab), BODY 150 (Painting and Refinishing), and BODY 150L (Painting and Refinishing Lab). Students will learn the following skills: welding, cutting, grinding, fabricating, dent repair, body filler application, priming, wetsanding, buffing, masking, panel removal and replacement, plastic repair, smc repair, single stage and two stage painting application, and other related skills.
