By earning an Associate of Science (AS) degree, you can continue at VU and pursue your bachelor's degree or you can transfer to another accredited school.

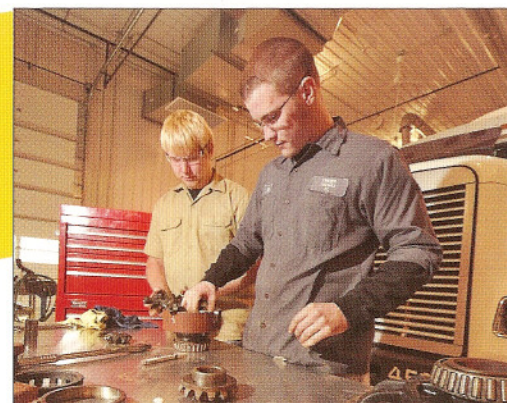

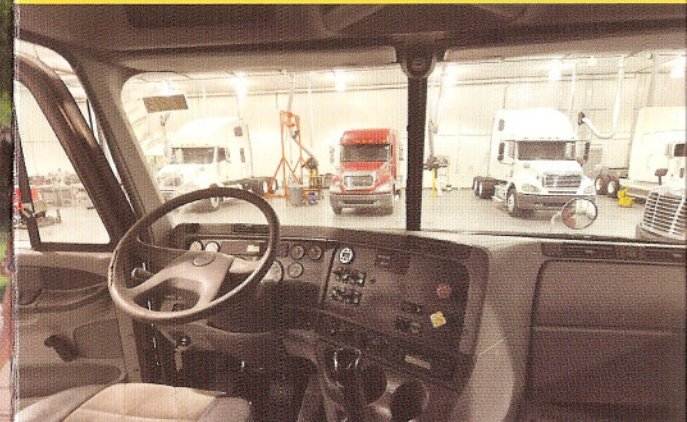
