PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Health Sciences program provides students with current health care education and basic patient care skills necessary to meet the needs of the health care industry. The student learns basic medical terminology, human anatomy and physiology, diseases/disorders related to human body systems, dementia care, and principles of becoming a medical assistant. The student not only acquires basic entry level skills necessary for functioning in the healthcare industry, but also has the opportunity to earn an industry recognized career-ready certification – CCMA. The student acquires basic entry-level skills necessary for functioning in the health care industry or for continuing his/her education in health careers. In addition, communication skills, medical career exploration, life skills and employability skills are taught. The program utilizes many health care facilities in the community as extended laboratories and job shadowing sites in conjunction with the traditional classroom. The program is structured to prepare students for a smooth transition into college or the job market.


Grade Level: 11th or 12th
