PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Structural Welding Certificate (CT) will prepare students to become American Welding Society (AWS) certified and earn an OSHA 10-Hour certification, to give them the skills needed to become a Production Welder. During this program, students will investigate various Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW), Gas Tungsten Arc Welding, (GTAW) & Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW) processes including: short circuit transfer, spray transfer, metal-core and flux-core (FCAW) welding. Welding techniques in all positions on various thicknesses of metal.

OUR GRADUATES:

Once you are finished, you will have earned 3 AWS certifications and an OSHA-10 certification. You will have the option of entering the workforce or completing the Technical Certificate (TC) in Welding Technology and the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree, with only a few more credit hours to complete
